Finally, I would like to share with you some changes to our homework provision. Please read the details below so that you can really help us help your children get the most from home learning.

How can parents support Home Learning?

Parents have an important role to play in supporting this approach to Home Learning. Simply sending your child to their room with a pencil and their homework book does not work. For our pupils to achieve success we need parents to take an interest in what their children are learning.

Here are some tips as to how parents can best support their children:

- 1. Make Time: your child will benefit from you taking an interest in what they are doing.
- Experiences: Try and link life and leisure experience to your child's school work e.g. visits to the park, museum or days out.
- 3. Talk: Make time to ask your child about what they are studying and what they have learned. Another great way to show you are interested is to attend school activities such as parents' evenings and sport events.

Year 3 and 4 will use words from RWI spelling scheme. Y5 and 6 will use RWI spelling scheme or generate ARE based words as necessary. Maths: KIRFS Timestables Rockstars 	Topic (wider curriculum) work as appropriate per topic (e.g. make a Roman shield) Mathletics Maths Software Package for any KS2 pupils who have access to a computer at home and will commit to doing this activity daily.
